"Another 100% Garnacha from high-up estate vines, these grown in shady conditions, the 2023 Alto de la Cruz is all whole-cluster fermented and spent 14 months in concrete. There's great refinement to the wine as a result, a texturally complex, nuanced embodiment of dried cherry, dried herb, and powerful spice. Made in a light, austere style, it's impressive in mineral and floral character, with chalky tannins that extend the finish. Small production with only 4,000 bottles. Drink through 2033."
