"The 2021 Las Anchas is from a great vintage and three spectacular plots, Las Anchas, Lentisco, and Central, with an average plant age of 77 years and 5% Graciano. With a lot of limestone in the soil and low yields, this shows the depth of concentration of old vines, nearly black in color, with silky smooth, supple tannins. It spent a longer time aging in new French oak barrel, 22 months. Newly released, it imparts layers of oak spice, dark cherry, and salty balsamic and is structured, powerfully full-bodied, and capable of aging 30-40 years. Let this lie another three to five years before opening."
